Bunny Care Information Sheet



Give rabbit pellets daily – preferably twice a day (I use Star rabbit pellets from Linda's Feed Store or Kelly's rabbit pellets from Tony's Feed – both in Norco).

Rabbits need clean water daily, from a crock. My rabbits don't drink from a water bottle as it is not as healthy for them.

Bunnies are sensitive to the heat and sun. Be sure they have shade at ALL times. You can fill a 2-liter bottle with water and freeze it for hot days. The bunnies will lie next to it to keep cool. You can also put water misters near their cage or bring them indoors if it is too hot. The first sign of an overheated rabbit is a wet nose. They also must be protected form the wind and rain.

If rabbits are kept indoors they can be litter box trained. Bunnies can live to be 10-years of age or sometimes longer if cared for properly.

Babies can only be kept together until 3-months of age. They can begin to breed as early as 4-months of age and can die if they are bred too young. They are considered adults at 6-months of age and are ready to breed.
